1. The short version

We use only the cookies the site needs to work and to keep it secure. **We do not use advertising cookies, analytics cookies, or tracking pixels.** There is no Meta/Facebook Pixel, no Google Analytics, and no advertising network on this site.

Fonts, scripts and country-flag artwork are **served from our own domain**. They used to come from a font host and a code CDN, which meant those companies saw your IP address every time a page rendered — so we moved the files here instead. The only third-party content left on the site is the **Cloudflare Turnstile** security check on the sign-in screen, explained below.

2. What a cookie is here

A cookie is a small file stored by your browser. Related browser storage does the same job, and we use it too, so in this policy "cookie" covers both.

3. Cookies we set — strictly necessary

These cannot be switched off, because without them the site cannot keep you signed in or protect itself from abuse.

Cookie	Purpose	Typical lifetime
Session cookie — openyoustyle-session	Keeps your browsing session together — remembers that requests come from the same visitor, keeps you signed in to your account	120 minutes
CSRF token cookie (XSRF-TOKEN)	Security. Ensures that a form submitted to us really came from our page and not from a malicious site	Session

Cookie	Purpose	Typical lifetime
Device identifier — <code>noor_fp</code> in browser storage	A random value generated in your browser the first time you use the sign-in screen, sent with sign-in requests so repeated automated attempts from one device can be spotted. It is not linked to advertising and is not shared.	Until you clear your browser storage

We do not read these for any purpose other than the ones above.

Both cookies are set by our own site. The session cookie is `HttpOnly` (not readable by scripts) and uses `SameSite=Lax` ; neither is used for advertising or profiling.

4. Third-party content loaded on our pages

Your browser fetches some page elements directly from other companies. Whenever it does, that company necessarily receives your **IP address**, your browser and device details, and the address of the page you are on. Each of them may set or read their own cookies under their own policies.

Service	Why it is on the page	What it means for you
Cloudflare Turnstile (<code>challenges.cloudflare.com</code>)	Bot protection for the sign-in step. The script loads on the sign-in page and on the account and pricing pages, which carry the same sign-in dialog; the check itself runs when a verification code is requested	Cloudflare receives your IP address and runs a browser check. It may set or read cookies or browser storage entries needed to run and remember that check. the cookie names are listed in Cloudflare's own Turnstile documentation; we set none of our own for it

How the check is set up. We use the **standard Turnstile widget**: it issues a **one-time token** for that sign-in attempt, which our server verifies once and discards. We do **not** use Cloudflare's *pre-clearance* mode — the mode that issues a `cf_clearance` cookie to admit the visitor to the whole site — so the widget is not being used to place a site-wide clearance cookie.

The Turnstile check runs only where the operator has enabled it; when it is switched off, the widget is not loaded at all.

No longer applicable. Earlier versions of this page listed a code CDN and a font host here. Those files are now served from our own domain, so no third party receives your IP address for them. Fonts, the JavaScript libraries and the country-flag artwork in the phone picker are all local.

5. Cookies we do NOT use

Verified against the source code of the site:

- **No analytics.** No Google Analytics, no Meta/Facebook Pixel, no TikTok pixel, no Snap pixel, no Hotjar, no Clarity, no heatmaps, no session recording — no analytics cookies or scripts of any kind. Server-side usage analytics without cookies is described in the [Privacy Policy](#).
- **No advertising or retargeting cookies.** We do not build advertising audiences from your visit and we do not share your browsing with ad networks.
- **No affiliate tracking cookies set by us.** See the [Affiliate Disclosure](#) for how purchase links work.
- **No cross-site profiling, and no sale of your data.**

6. Your choices

- **Browser controls.** You can block or delete cookies in your browser settings. If you block the strictly necessary cookies above, sign-in and form submissions will stop working.
- **Blocking third-party content.** Browser privacy modes and content blockers can prevent the third-party assets in Section 4 from loading. The site may then look or behave differently — for example, sign-in may be unavailable if the bot-protection widget is blocked.
- **Consent.** We do not ask for cookie consent today, because we set only strictly necessary cookies. If we ever add analytics or advertising cookies, we will ask for your consent first, and you will be able to refuse without losing access to the try-on.
